



## BATTLEGROUND SEATS

LONDON SW1A 0AA

The baseline is a notional Labour overall majority of 47, so that Opposition parties would need to gain 24 seats from Labour, with no countervailing Labour gains, to remove Labour's overall majority in Parliament. Labour holds 27 seats with a majority of less than 3% over its main opponent, so which would change hands with a universal 1.5% swing.
