Subject: Award of HI (M) and Release of Benefits

AGs branch (PS Directorate letter # 4821/7795/16006/ PS-1CA) dated 21st July, 2008.

1. My request for award of HI (M) was processed and was not acceded to, due to constraints in the rules and regulations as per the contents of the letter under reference.
2. Rules and regulations of the Army, however, played no role in my unjust, unfair and unwarranted retirement which was wholly and solely based on a devious military intelligence plot based on fabrication, deceit and lies, planned and executed by two General Officers, namely [REDACTED]. Unfortunately, this lowly [REDACTED] level plot was bought hook, line and sinker by the then COAS, General Pervaiz Musharraf, who, without an enquiry and without even giving me an audience, retired me in one day!
3. In this plot, [REDACTED] was made to pick up my loyal and trustworthy driver while I was on an official visit to the UK and subsequently my driver was forced under duress to give false statement against me, which was then converted into primary evidence by these General Officers, but I was not even confronted with any kind of evidence. To top the cruelty, all my benefits were seized so as to control my response and were, thereafter, dished out to me, intermittently later, as "oxygen for survival", whenever I was in a tight financial situation.

4. Your good self was kind enough to release my last benefit which had still not been released even when your kindself took over as COAS, despite the fact that General Pervaiz Musharraf had called me to his Presidential Camp Office, three days prior to the declaration of the Emergency in the country, and had requested me simply to forget the past and extended his hand to me for a renewal of friendship.

5. He even asked me to forgive both these General Officers and be friends with them again. I found all this very surprising after the very uncouth manner in which I had been retired without any enquiry/legal procedure. On this occasion too, I did emphatically apprise him of the actual reasons behind that devious plot against me and reasons why it had been hatched. He simply requested me to be nice enough to bury the past which actually is NOT easy, keeping in view the social ostracization, psychological and financial agony/trauma suffered by me and my family because of this unjust retirement, whereas, the perpetrators of this criminal plot, [REDACTED], continue to enjoy [REDACTED] positions in the Army, [REDACTED], while, alternatively, I on the other hand, struggle in the civil world for a living. They apparently, have managed to get away, scot free, something which I do intend contesting.

6. Also, right after my retirement, a very negative press coverage based on total lies was given about me in the press, [REDACTED] and all this obviously, had been done as per his instructions. After my retirement, my family and I were also physically harassed and isolated by [REDACTED] for three continuous months, during which a slanderous and malicious campaign was also spread against me to dishonour me. This later also resulted in contributing to my daughter's divorce. Such was his venom towards me!

7. Therefore, in order to re-store my honour, when the overall environment changed, i-e after General Musharraf retracted from his previous stance and asked for a renewal in friendship, I made the humble request for the award of the HI (M) and had also requested

you personally in my interview with you to adjust me on a befitting job, commensurate with my rank, so as to, basically, re-instate my honour. Hence, if the award of HI (M) is not possible. I shall humbly request you for adjusting me in an appropriate job which by itself, would be enough to re-instate my honour. The feeling of being rehabilitated may heal many a wound in my case, at least.

8. I would also request your kindness to please initiate an enquiry into the reasons/circumstances of my retirement so that some kind of disciplinary action can be taken against these General officers, who grossly misused their office [REDACTED] in order to settle personal scores/animosities, which resulted in a General Officer being despatched on retirement, in a manner worse than an OR i-e overnight, without even a charge sheet. This is a retirement UNPRECEDENTED in the history of the Pakistan Army. The entire purpose of this plot by these General officers was to hide their own involvement in a matter they knew, I was privy to. They felt vulnerable and, therefore, spun this mischievous and deceitful plot. I will not reveal further details here but before an enquiry, I will furnish all relevant proof/information, which is readily available with me.

9. I pray for and anticipate a just response from you as enough injustice has already been perpetuated on me which I have borne very silently till today, waiting for the right time to come to redeem myself. The time for my seeking due justice has come and the restoration of my honour is and will remain my primary focus.
