#### Queen Elizabeth II's early life and reign:

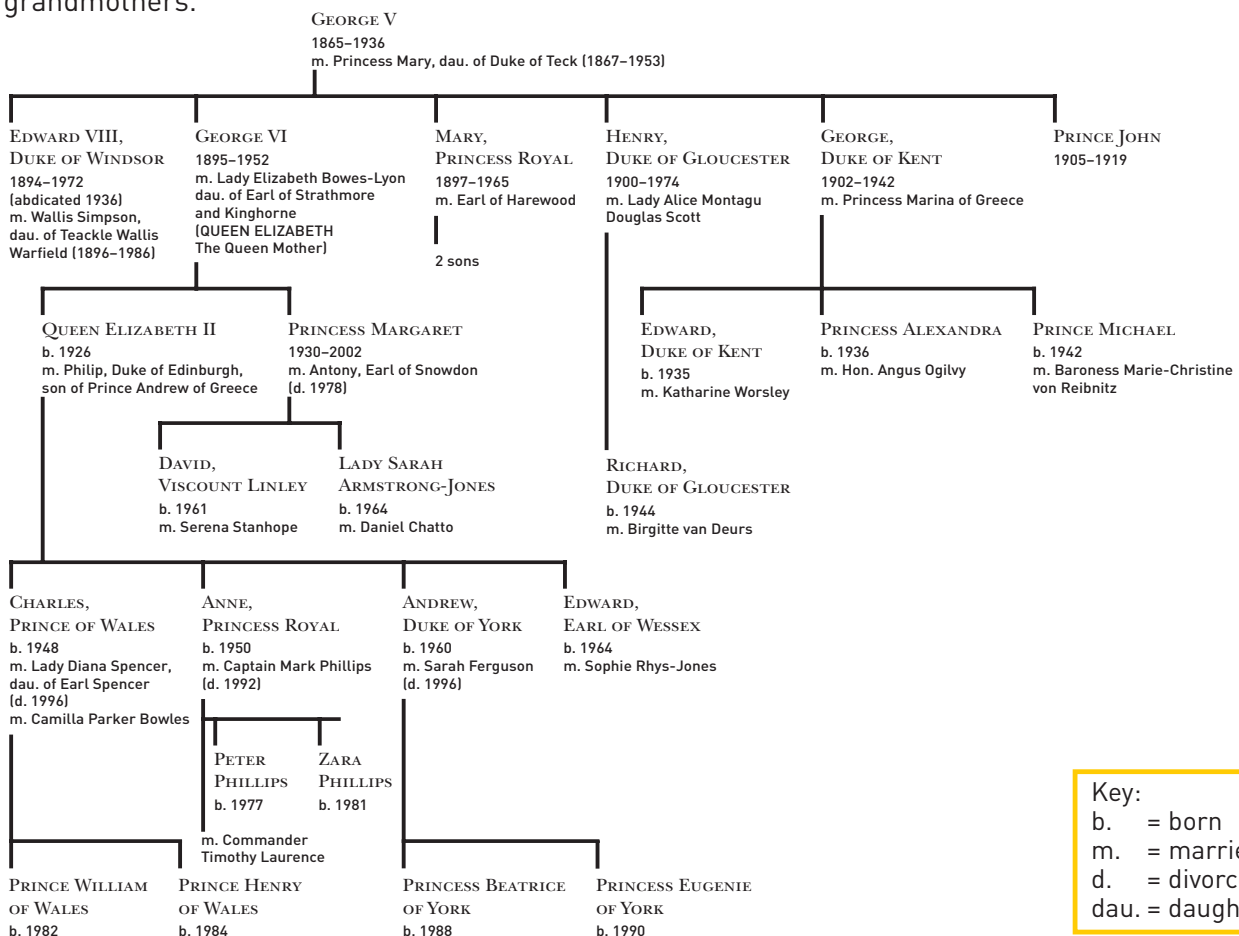
The following information represents Queen Elizabeth II's early life and reign. Use your own sources of research to complete the answers below by writing the corresponding letter next to each date.
