

## Biography of Dame Sandra Dawson

Dame Sandra Dawson is KPMG Professor of Management Studies at the Judge Business School, Cambridge University and Master of Sidney Sussex College.

She writes and consults on organisational behaviour, leadership, innovation and health management, and is the author of four books and numerous articles.

She is a non-executive director of Barclays Bank, Oxfam and Cambridge Econometrics and a member of The UK-India Round Table, the Fire and Rescue Service Ministerial Sounding Board, and the External Advisory Committee of the Ruskin School of Fine Art, University of Oxford.

She was director of the Judge Business School from 1995 to 2006. Her previous academic posts were in Imperial College, London.

In 2004, she was awarded a CBE for her contribution to higher education and management research. In 2006 she was inducted into the International Women's Forum (IWF) Hall of Fame after becoming the first female Master of one of the Cambridge colleges founded originally for men and for her achievements in guiding the development of the Judge Business School within Cambridge University.
