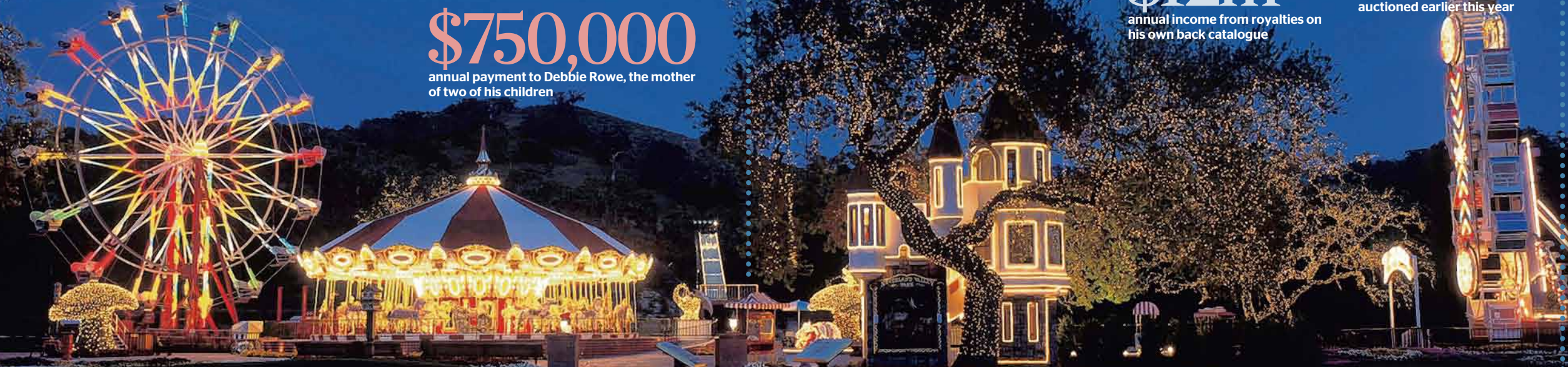

pressurised oxygen chamber (1986)

rumoured monthly rent on a nine bedroom mansion in Beverly Hills when he could not bear to return to Neverland in 2004

## \$3m

bail after arrest on abuse charges in 2003

## \$4m

annual staffing bill

## \$4m

shopping spree at Las Vegas emporium in 2003, including a giant marble chess set and 10ft tall glass urns

## \$25m

reported 1994 out-of-court settlement with family of Jordan Chandler over abuse allegations

## \$10,000

monthly payment to a Beverly Hills chemist

## \$67,000

for cream to treat his skin complaint, vitiligo

## \$150,000

to put voodoo curses on 25 "enemies", including Steven Spielberg and David Geffen, according to *Vanity Fair* in 2003, with further payments to strengthen the spell with a ritual bath of animals' blood, for which 80 animals were killed
