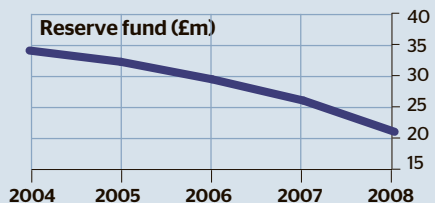
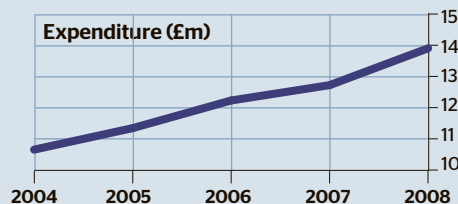
The Queen costs

Civil List

£7.9m

Where the money is going

- Royal Train fixed cost £500,000 a year
- State visit to Slovenia and Slovakia £93,505 by charter flight
- Garden parties £600,000 a year
- Helicopter £1.6m a year, including nine staff, and flight costs
