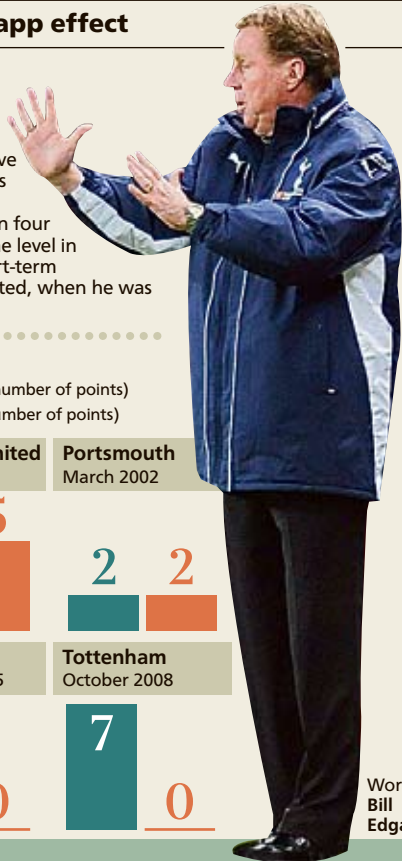


# Cashing in on the Redknapp effect

Tottenham Hotspur's improvement since Harry Redknapp's arrival reflects their manager's history of engineering sudden changes in fortune for his new clubs. After his five mid-season managerial appointments he has overseen an upturn in league results over the first three matches on four occasions, while maintaining the same level in the remaining instance. The one short-term deterioration came at West Ham United, when he was appointed during the close season
