

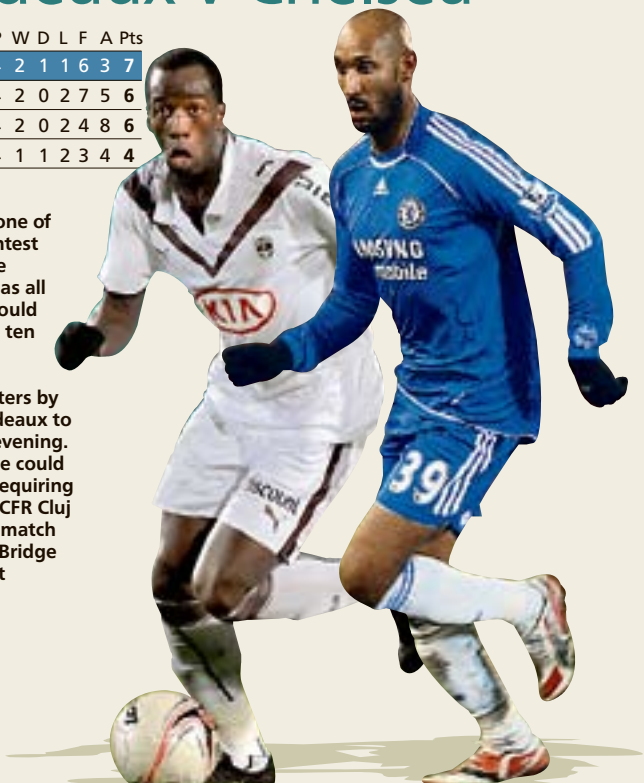


# Bordeaux v Chelsea

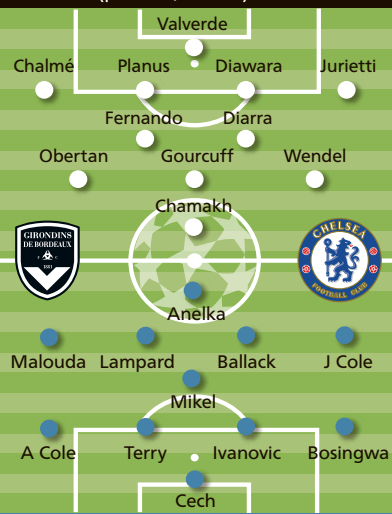


## Key clash
