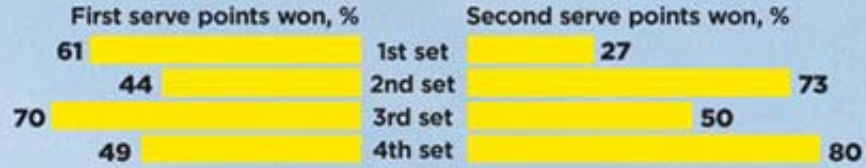


Serving up a grand-slam triumph

Percentage of points won on first serve

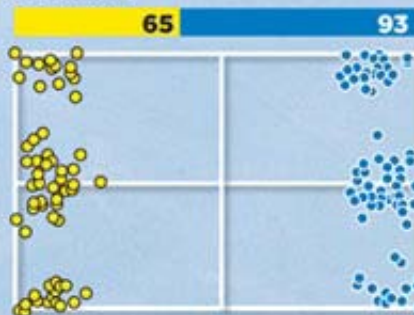


Percentage of points won on second serve

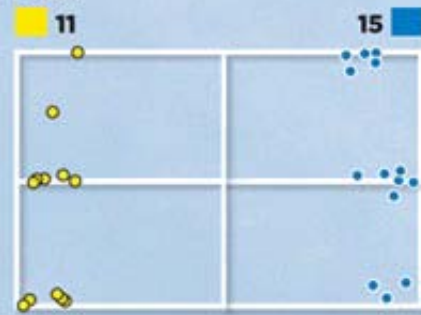
