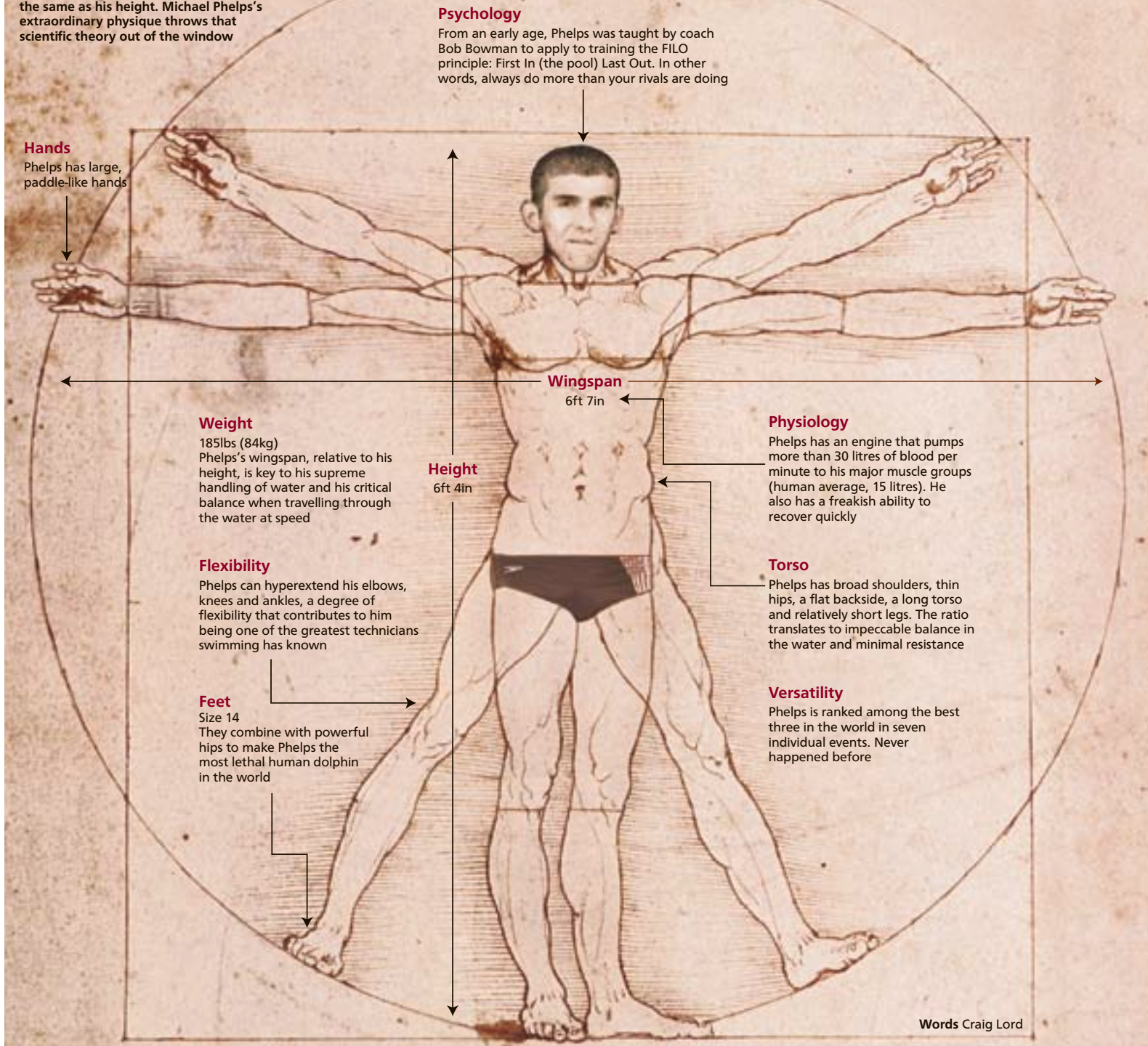


The anatomy of a champion
